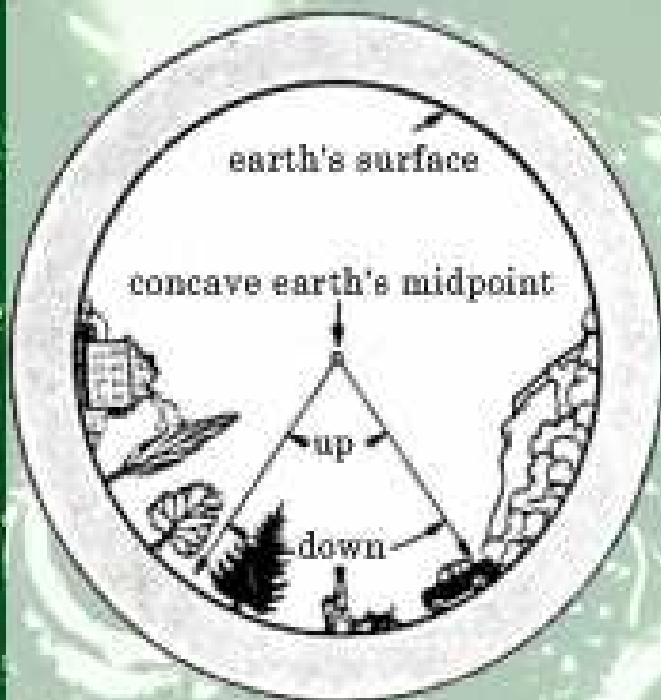


Theoretical Frameworks and Empirical Underdetermination
