

Economics Minor at Utrecht School of Economics, Utrecht University, Netherlands

Students at the Institute of Social Sciences at the Heinrich Heine Universität Düsseldorf can do a minor in economics at Utrecht School of Economics (USE) starting in September 2006.

These courses are all taught in English. Utrecht University and USE work on a period system, in which each semester is broken down into two periods. A full course load consists of two courses of 7,5 ECTS each period, and therefore four courses each semester for a total of 30 ECTS.
